WHAT WAS THE GOAL?

To formally establish a network that spans across Brighton and Hove and Lewes, High Wealds and Havens CCGs that identifies the workforce gaps in primary care, supports recruitment and retention and facilitates professional development and multi-professional education.

WHAT DID THC ACHIEVE?

Over 18 months, THC successfully:

- Implemented a governance framework which spans multiple CCGs.
- Secured £123k of operational funding.
- Facilitated 9 HCA Apprenticeships.
- Delivered workforce planning workshops to a group of merging practices.
- Formed part of the leadership team at integrated primary and community Protected Learning Time event which was attended by 350 people.











WHAT DID THEY SAY?

"There was no blueprint for this project and required development from the bottom up to meet local need. It was a totally different way of working and was not without its detractors as well as having little financial support, short deadlines and a requirement to engage many different organisations with varying resource challenges.
